

GRADUATE STUDENT SUMMER REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Welcome to Emerson College! We strongly encourage all graduate students entering Emerson in the Fall 2009 semester to participate in advising and registration for fall classes from today through August 15, 2009. This will give you the maximum choice in course selection and help you determine your schedule as early as possible.

Guidelines for Registration

1. **You must pay your \$200.00 tuition deposit to the Graduate Admission Office prior to registration.**
2. Summer advising and registration will be done **by telephone and email** with your Graduate Program Director. The process varies by program, so follow the instructions below. Confirmation of your registration will be sent by email.
3. If you do not participate in summer advising and registration by August 15, you will be advised and registered on September 10, 2009 during Graduate Orientation.

Journalism: All incoming journalism graduate students will take the following two courses:

1. JR 600, Reporting and Writing Across the Media (8 credits). Choose from two sections
Section 1: 10:00-1:45 Tuesday and Thursday and 10:00-11:45 Friday
Section 2: 10:00-1:45 Monday and Wednesday and 10:00-11:45 Friday
Exemptions to JR600 are not normally allowed*
2. JR 601, News and Society (4 credits) 5:00-5:45 Mondays and Wednesdays
