CHANGE OF STATUS

If (1) you are currently in the U.S. **AND** (2) you are not planning to travel outside of the U.S. before your studies at Emerson College **AND** (3) you have an immigration status that is **NOT** F-1, then you will need to apply to the USCIS (United States Citizenship and Immigration Services) for a "Change of Status."

After you receive your Form I-20 from the Office of Graduate Admission, you **MUST** contact the Office of International Student Affairs at (617) 824-7858. Failure to do so could jeopardize your lawful status in the United States.

CERTIFICATION OF FINANCES

You are required to show that you have enough funds for your academic and living expenses for one year. The **estimated** cost of attendance for the 2010-2011 academic year is US\$37,000 (US\$47,000 for Global Marketing Communication and Advertising only).

Please provide us with a **bank document** which is: (1) in English; (2) in US Dollars; (3) an original copy; (4) shows a minimum of US\$37,000; (5) signed by a bank official; (6) issued within 12 months of the start date of your program.

If this bank document represents the finances of someone other than you, then please also include a **letter of sponsorship**. The letter of sponsorship should state, **"I, (name of sponsor and relationship to you), am financially able and willing to support (name of applicant) for a minimum of US\$37,000 per year for graduate study at Emerson College."**

Please make sure your financial sponsor signs and dates the letter. You can download a sample from our website, www.emerson.edu/admission/graduate.

Please note, The Office of Graduate Admission will NOT be able to issue any immigration documents on your behalf without these financial documents. In addition, you must submit your **tuition deposit** and **your final undergraduate college/university transcript** clearly showing that you received a degree before we can issue your immigration documents.

Please keep in mind that under normal circumstances, students holding student (F-1) visas cannot work off-campus to support themselves. Unless you are offered one of our highly competitive Graduate Assistantships at the time of admission, you should not anticipate employment, either part-time during the academic year or full-time during the summer, as a means of support while at Emerson College.
