Abstract:

The Phil Leslie Script Collection consists of unbound scripts written by Phil Leslie, the bulk of which are from the radio show *Fibber McGee and Molly*, that aired from 1935-1956 on WMAQ/Chicago and then on the NBC Monitor until 1959. There are also some bound scripts from the earlier show *Smackout*, which also featured Jim and Marian Jordan.

It also consists of unbound scripts of the television show *Dennis the Menace*. This show ran on CBS from 1959 until 1963.

There are unbound scripts from other shows that Phil Leslie wrote for including ten radio programs and twenty- five television series.

Included are sketch ideas, outlines and draft scripts as well as final versions.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE:

Phil Leslie, was a great comedic writer starting in radio and later moving on to write for television. He started out his life in St. Louis Missouri as bookkeeper for a bank. During this time he married his wife Helen, and they had four children Anne, Jane, Sue, and Phil Jr. In 1939 he left the bank business to pursue his dream as a writer. In 1943 he was hired as an assistant writer, working with Don Quinn, for the radio show *Fibber McGee and Molly Show*. Following Quinn's retirement Leslie took over as head writer of the show. He was the head

writer until the shows end in 1959. In 1959-1960 there was an attempt to do a TV spin off of the radio show with Phil Leslie as the writer, but this was unsuccessful.

The famous Fibber McGee and Molly Radio Show from WMAQ/Chicago, one of the longest running radio shows, aired from 1935-1959, with the last three years aired by the NBC Monitor. Jim Jordan (1896-1988) was the voice of Fibber McGee and Marian (Driscoll) Jordan (1898-1961) was the voice of Molly.

Jordan and Driscoll were both from Peoria, Illinois and married in 1924. They joined with writer Donald Quinn in 1931 for their first radio show *Smackout*. Originally only broadcasted locally on WMAQ Chicago the show went national in 1933 and lasted until 1935. Fibber McGee and Molly would grow out from this show.

After this show ended Quinn developed the characters of Fibber McGee and Molly with the Jordan's. The show premiered in 1935, and after a few years it was a hit. It was sponsored by S.C. Johnson wax company from 1935-1950, the commercials were integrated into the show by the character Harlow Wilcox who Fibber usually met with a groan because he was always praising S.C. Johnson's wax. The show was sponsored by Pet Milk from 1950-1952, and then by Reynolds Aluminum until 1953. After 1953 the show went from doing half hour episodes to fifteen minute episodes due to the declining health of Marian Jordan and the declining popularity of radio. By the time the show ended in 1959 they were five minute episodes.

Leslie also wrote for *The Beulah Show* a spinoff of the *Fibber McGee and Molly Show*. Another spinoff of the show was *The Great Gildersleeves* which was a radio success in its own right.

As radio was on its way out and television was on its way in Leslie moved on to write for television. He started by writing for the TV spinoff of the *Fibber McGee and Molly Show*, which lasted for one season and was unsuccessful he later went on to write for *Dennis the Menace* until the show ended in 1963.

Leslie also wrote episodes for such shows as *I Love Lucy*, *The Brady Bunch*, *Dobie Gillis*, *Get Smart*, *Mr. Ed*, *The Addams Family*, *Julie*, *Family Affair*, *Green Acres*, *The Farmer's Daughter*, *The Beverly Hillbillies*, *Petticoat Junction*, *Hazel*, *Bachelor Father*, and *Leave it to Beaver*.

He died in at the age of 79 in 1988 from cancer.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

The bulk of this collection contains bound and unbound scripts of the radio show *Fibber McGee and Molly*. The bound scripts are from 1937 to 1953 and the unbound scripts date from 1941-1954. Included with many of the unbound scripts are the story pitches, outlines, draft scripts, notes from readings and the final drafts. There are also some of the scripts from the TV spinoff that was attempted, and draft scripts for a movie that never went to production. Over the many years *Fibber McGee and Molly* was on they did special appearances outside of their scheduled time for various organizations. During their regular shows they did many spots during World

War II about supporting the troops and supporting the American Red Cross. They would advertise special drives that were going on or explain ways in which people could conserve. Included in the collections are letters from the various organizations asking them to mention a specific thing like a clothes drive or the advantages of buying war bonds. They also sometimes did special episodes for a specific organization, like the American Cancer Society.

The second series contains the unbound scripts from *The Dennis the Menace Show* these date from 1960 to 1963. Included here are outlines and drafts of the scripts.

Phil Leslie wrote for many shows over the years and some of the scripts that he wrote are included here. The earlier ones were for radio shows and the later for television shows.

Series 1: Fibber McGee and Molly Radio Scripts

Arrangement: This series was kept in its original order, which is chronological.

Dates: 1943-1954.

Volume: 14.5 linear ft.

Scope and content note: This series includes the bound and unbound scripts from the Fibber McGee and Molly Radio Show. The bound scripts are from 1937 to 1953. The unbound scripts start in 1941, and include outlines, drafts, and final versions. Note that script numbers come from what was written on the original folder. At the end of this series can be found what has been called "Special Scripts" these include scripts for the TV pilot of the show, scripts for a movie that was never went to production, a series from the 70's about the *Good Old Days of Radio*, and other special programs that were done over the years.

Series 2: Dennis the Menace Television Scripts

Arrangement: This series was kept in its original order, which is chronological.
